Your requests have been processed in accordance with the FOIA, 5 U.S.C. § 552, as amended. A thorough search of our files and databases located two videos responsive to your requests, which are being released to you in part.

Material withheld from release is denied pursuant to FOIA exemptions:

- (b)(1) as properly classified information under Executive Order 13526, Sections 1.4(c), (e), (g). To the extent that the classified information in the responsive videos is over 25 years old, we have determined that it qualifies for continued classification under Executive Order 13526, Section 3.3 (b)(1); and
- (b)(3), which is the basis for withholding information exempt from disclosure by statute. The relevant withholding statute are 10 U.S.C. § 424.

You have the right to appeal this determination to the NRO Appellate Authority, 14675 Lee Road, Chantilly, VA 20151-1715, within 90 days of the above date.
