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The "Daily Worker," on 4/19/57, pg. 3, col. 3, carried an article under the heading "Socialist Groups Call May Day Rally." The article reported that "A United May Day rally, representing a broad cross section of New York socialist and progressive opinion," was scheduled for Wednesday night, 5/1/57, at Central Plaza Hall, New York City, according to an announcement on the previous day by the Committee For Socialist Unity, which group reportedly was sponsoring the meeting. The article stated that STANLEY LEVINSON, chairman of the March on Washington movement formed in 1941, would speak at the rally on the forthcoming Pilgrimage of Prayer. It stated further that the rally would "focus on ending the blight of segregation in American life, particularly in the South, where the issue of integration is approaching a climax."

Similar articles were carried in the "Daily Worker" issues of 4/29/57, page 2, columns 1, 2 and 3, and 4/30/57, page 2, columns 4 and 5, and in "The Worker" (Sunday edition of the "Daily Worker")4/21/57, page 16, columns 1 and 2.


The "Daily Worker" issue of 5/1/57, on page 4, columns 2 and 3, published an item under the heading "Correction," stating that the "Daily Worker" had on the previous day received a telegram from the Prayer Pilgrimage Committee requesting the publication of the following correction to an eroneous report carried in several issues of the paper:

"It was eroneously reported in the Daily and Sunday Worker that STANLEY LEVINSON, chairman of the Executive Committee of the March on Washington Committee, would



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speak on 5/1/57, at the Socialist Unity Forum meeting. Mr. LEVINSON is not speaking, nor can any other speaker be present for the March on Washington Committee of 1941 which is not in existence, nor any representative of Prayer Pilgrimage Committee. The Prayer Pilgrimage Committee is not cooperating with any political group or parties."



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
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
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Subject's activities in connection with "In Friendship" have been reported to the Bureau in previous correspondence in this case as well as in the case captioned "In Friendship - IS-C", (Bureau 100-424895).

The Prayer Pilgrimage for Freedom was a gathering at Washington to advocate civil rights legislation held 5/17/57, on the anniversary of the Supreme Court's segregation decision, which gathering was sponsored by the NAACP, The Brotherhood of Sleeping Car Porters and various church and Negro groups.

Philip kandolph, March chairman, publicly announced that one Stanley Levinson was partially responsible for the initiation of the mechanics of this activity as well as the similar-type demonstration held in Washington, D. C., on 10-25-58. Eue to previous information that Stanley Cavid Levison, your file 100-111180, has been closely associated with Reverend Martin Luther King, who was very active on behalf of captioned demonstration, it appears that Levinson and Levison are one and the same.

Washington Field Office also advised that the Kational Association for the Advancement of Colored Feople was sponsoring a Youth March rally and victory dance on 5-10-59 in New York City. It was also announced that there would be a Freedom Day rally on the Central Park Mall in New York City on 5-17-59 to celebrate the Supreme Court's decision on school desegregation.

The Bureau desires that you promptly furnish any substantiating data in your files linking Stanley David Levison to captioned demonstration, particularly as it pertains to financial support of this demonstration. You should also remain alert for information concerning the above activities acheduled for 5/16 and 17/59 and keep the Bureau advised of pertinent developments. If there is information indicating Communist Party interest in one or both of these activities, the Bureau should be advised and you should effect informant coverage of these activities.

On 2/26/60, STANLEY LEVISON was observed unaccompanied at the intersection of 106th Street and Broadway, NYC. SAS and and approached LEVISON, recalled to him their enrier contact, and inquired if the time was convenient for a discussion.

LEVISON, in a friendly manner replied, "well, I'm a little strapped for time. I'm due at my office. You can wall: with me to the subway and we can talk along the way." The Agents agreed.

Bureau's responsibility in the internal security field was explained to LEVISON, who acknowledged by stating that he understood. LEVISON then said that he once thought about the FDI as a career for himself. He clarified this remark by stating that when he grandated from law school he was in the top ten in his class, and, if he recalled correctly, such a scholastic record sould, at that time, facilitate employment with the Bureau. LEVISON said further that it was the uncertain hours and the possibility of being transferred throughout the sountry that made him decide against it.

At this point in the conversation, the Agents and LEVISCH were approaching the entrance to the submay. It was suggested to LEVISCH that he gide downtown with the Agents in their Bureau ear where they would drop him off in the vicinity of his office building. LEVISCH accepted. The conversation continued and the Bureau's jurisdiction in the internal security field was brought to the more exactly ease of ALFRED K. STEEN (Fugitive-Espionage Agent).

MIVISON remarked, "oh, that guy. You, I mot him several times. Ask me how many times or even the last time I am him and I couldn't, for the life of me, give you an enswer." LEVISON continued by stating that at one time he (LEVISON) was active in an organization known as "Businessmen For Roosevelt" (LETA) and that he went to STHEN's office in Rockefeller Center in an attempt to stilling office in Rockefeller Center in an attempt to sell him mailing lists which the EFR had acquired. LEVISON stated that STEEN could use those lists in the "sallace For President" campaign that STEEN was promoting. LEVISON stated that STEEN did not buy the lists as he considered them worthless since they were several years old. LEVISON then reasoned that his contacts with salls probably occurred during the late fortice.

"sube" who seemed obsessed with the fact that he was a millionaire and that just being a millionaire made him an important person. LEVISCH said that if STERN was a millionaire, he just barely made it and was the "cheapest" millionaire he ever met. LEVISCH continued by saying that his opinion of STERN might be due in part to past conversations he had had with his brother ROY, who had brief business dealings with STERN and who was mimilarly impressed.

LEVISCH further examented by saying he did not know any acquaintances or associates of STERN, that he had no indication that STERN might have been involved in espionage or with Soviet officials. LEVISON stated that once, at STERN's office, he had not MARTHA DOUD STERN, and that sho impressed him as being a "typical snob,"

when asked if, to his knowledge, STERN might have been associated with the CP or tenceivably, since he was reputedly a wealthy man, may have sontributed to the CP, LEVISCH replied by stating that he had no such information and "he'd be too cheap to contribute." "In fact", LEVISCH continued, "if I recall correctly, he once repeated to me a trite anti-Communist phrase, popular at the time, which went semething like, 'they ought to load them all on a boat and dump them out at seal."

LEVISON continued, "STE'N branged about the contributions he made to various charitable organizations, but from what he showed me, his contributions were nominal."

LEVISON stated that STERN was always trying to impress people with the fact that he was an important man. He was a great "name-dropper." He claimed to know all the "big shots." HERRY WALLACE was supposed to have a farm adjoining his property. MARSHALL FIELD was interested in a psychiatric institution located in Chicago that STERN supposedly sponsored.

Following LEVISON's mention of MARSHALL FIELD, he was acked if STERN had ever dropped the name of FREDENICK VANDENCIES FIELD. LEVISON replied, no, not that I recall, but I've heard of him. He's got real money. I think he is in Naxico."

It was discreetly pointed out to LEVISCH that the CP was also a matter of investigation by the Bureau within its jurisdiction in the internal security field and that any information he may have regarding the CP probably would be of assistance in this investigation.

LEVISON, who consistently endeavored to return the conversation to STERN and thus avoid a discussion of the CP, replied that he would not know how to classify STERN as far as his political thinking ment. LEVISON stated that he did not know much about the CP other than the fact that those who apparently were in it, now seemed thoroughly confused. LEVISON stated that he knew some people who probably could be called liberals, progressives, or communists, but that he would not make them because he believed a person should have "freedom of political thought." LEVISON continued by stating that you really can't classify these people today because there are Communists, enti-Communists, Communists who are enti-Communists, people who are left, people who are right, and people in between.

The interview was brought to a close when the vicinity of LEVISON's office was reached. Before departing, LEVISON agreed to meet at any time with the Agents


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and that should anything some to his attention which he believed would be of interest to the Bureau, he would not hesitate to contact the NYO. The interview terminated, as it had proceeded, on a friendly basis.

### Bynluction

LEVISON, throughout the interview, appeared to be slightly nervous, nevertheless, he talked freely about STERN and appeared to hold no animosity whatsoever against the Bureru in regard to its jurisdiction in the internal security field. LEVISON did, however, give the definite impression throughout the interview that he was trying to avoid a discussion of the CP and when the conversation would reach that point, it was evident that he was anxious to change the subject and would do so by returning to his discussion of STERN.

The interview was not of sufficient duration to determine the extent of his truthfulness or for that matter, to what degree he might further cooperate if asked more specific questions concerning his association with the CP.
